



## **CALLED FOR MORE PARISH PRIMARY POINT OF CONTACT KEY PARISH LEADERS SURVEY ADMINISTRATION**

### **What is this project all about?**

The Called For More Pilot is an initiative of the Catholic Leadership Institute (CLI). CLI received a grant from the Lilly Endowment to pilot a new process for supporting priests and parishes in thriving in ministry. By gathering information about each priest and each parish, the pilot seeks to give parishioners more awareness about the needs and opportunities of their local community, priests more awareness and support around their ongoing ministerial development, and the diocese better information with which to consider and discern priestly assignments and parish support.

### **What is the Key Parish Leader Survey?**

The Key Parish Leader (KPL) Survey collects specific input about the parish, focusing on the personality/culture of the parish from 5-10 active and influential parishioners identified by the pastor. It consists of 26 questions. The Survey questions can be found at the end of this document.

### **How do I administer the Key Parish Leader Survey?**

1. You will receive an email with a link to log onto the Called For More Platform.
2. You will create an account on the platform.
3. You will complete a Roster containing the names of the 5-10 key parish leaders who will receive the KPL Survey.
4. When you complete the Roster, emails will be sent to the key parish leaders with a link to the KPL Survey. They click on the link in their email and this takes them directly into the survey.
5. You take the survey.
6. You will monitor completion of the survey.

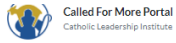

## Creating an Account

Click on the link that is in the email you received from the Called For More Platform.

Create a password. The password needs to be at least 8 characters, including one lowercase and one uppercase letter, one number, and one special character (! @ # \$ %). Only the special characters listed are accepted (so you **cannot** use a ?, &, or \*) and spaces are not accepted.







### What We are Asking of You

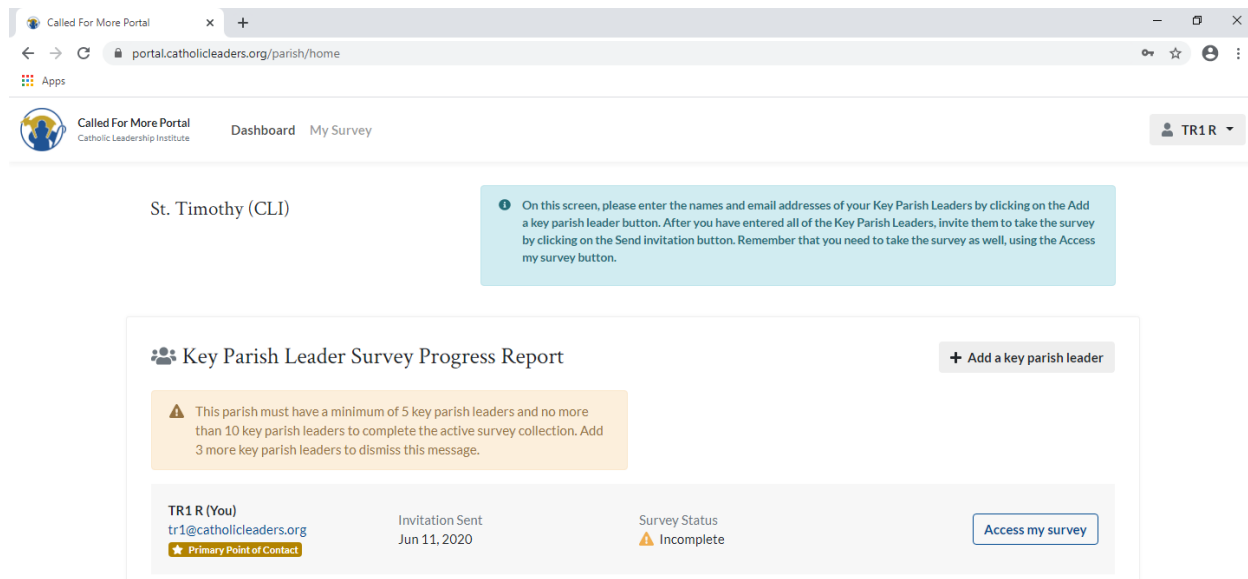

To learn more about your parish, we need input from Key Parish Leaders. Key Parish Leaders are active and influential parishioners. They will provide input through the Key Parish Leaders Survey. The survey should be sent to between 5-10 Key Parish Leaders. As the PPOC, you are also considered a Key Parish Leader and you will take the survey as well. You will be asked to follow-up with key parish leaders to make sure they complete the survey.

Your next steps are to create a Roster of Key Parish Leaders and send out the Survey to them.

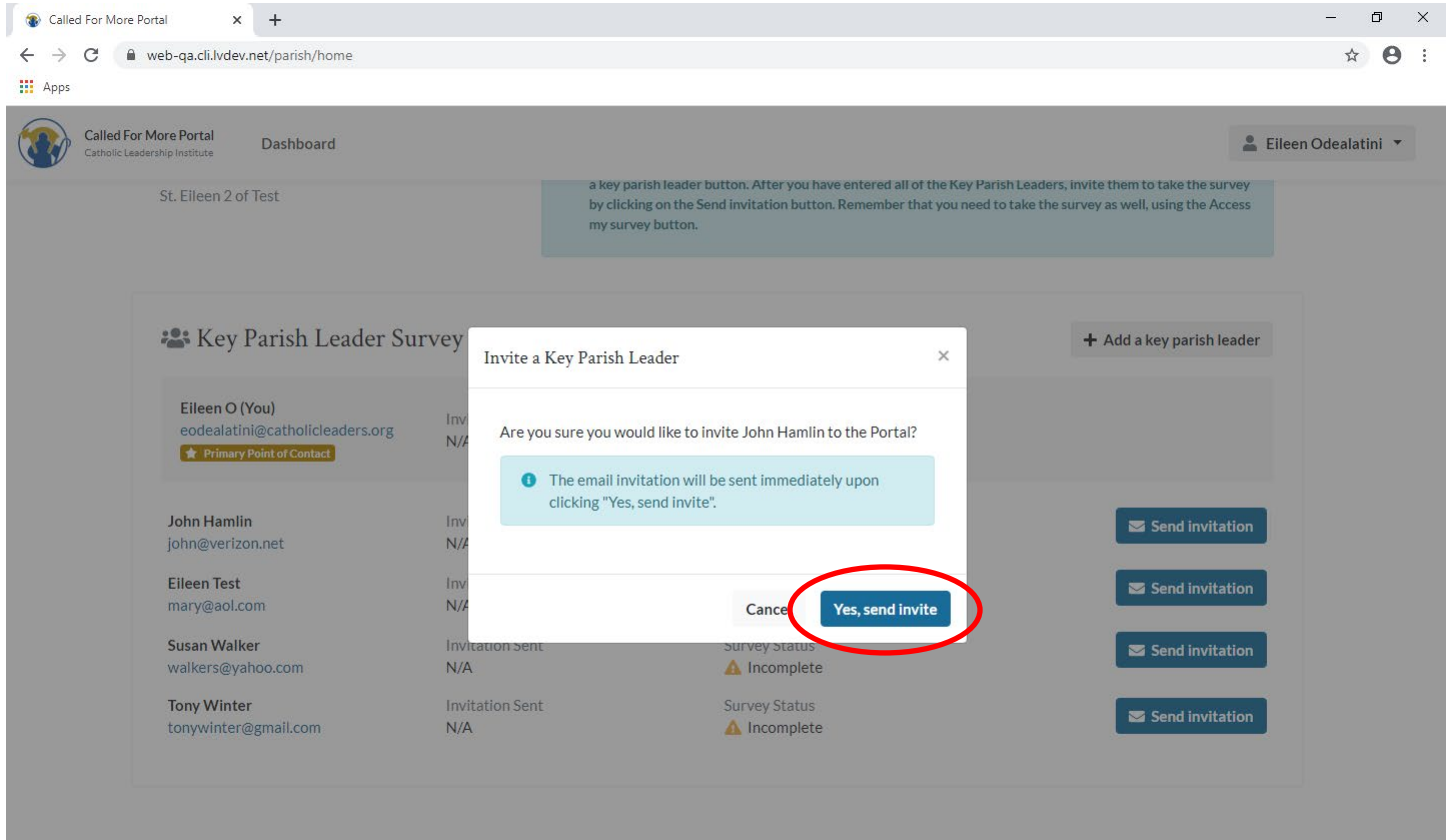

## PPOC of More Than One Parish

If you are the Parish Primary Point of Contact for more than one parish, you need to create a roster of Key Parish Leaders for each parish and take the survey yourself for each parish.

To access additional parishes, you click on your name which is displayed in the upper right side of the screen. When you click on your name, you will get a drop-down list of the parishes for which you are the PPOC. Select the appropriate parish.



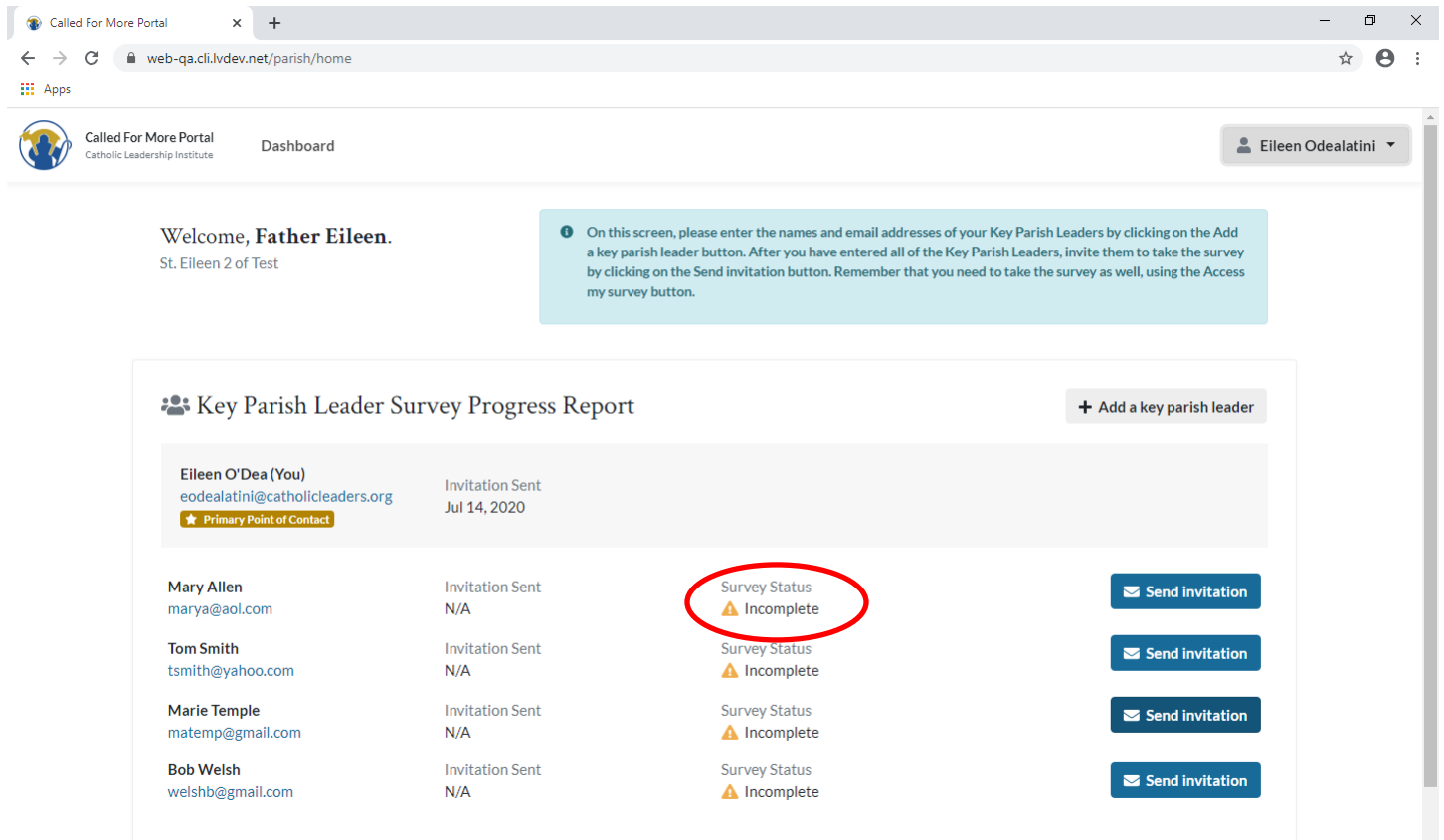
## Checking on Key Parish Leaders Completion of Survey

### Survey Won't Advance to Next Question

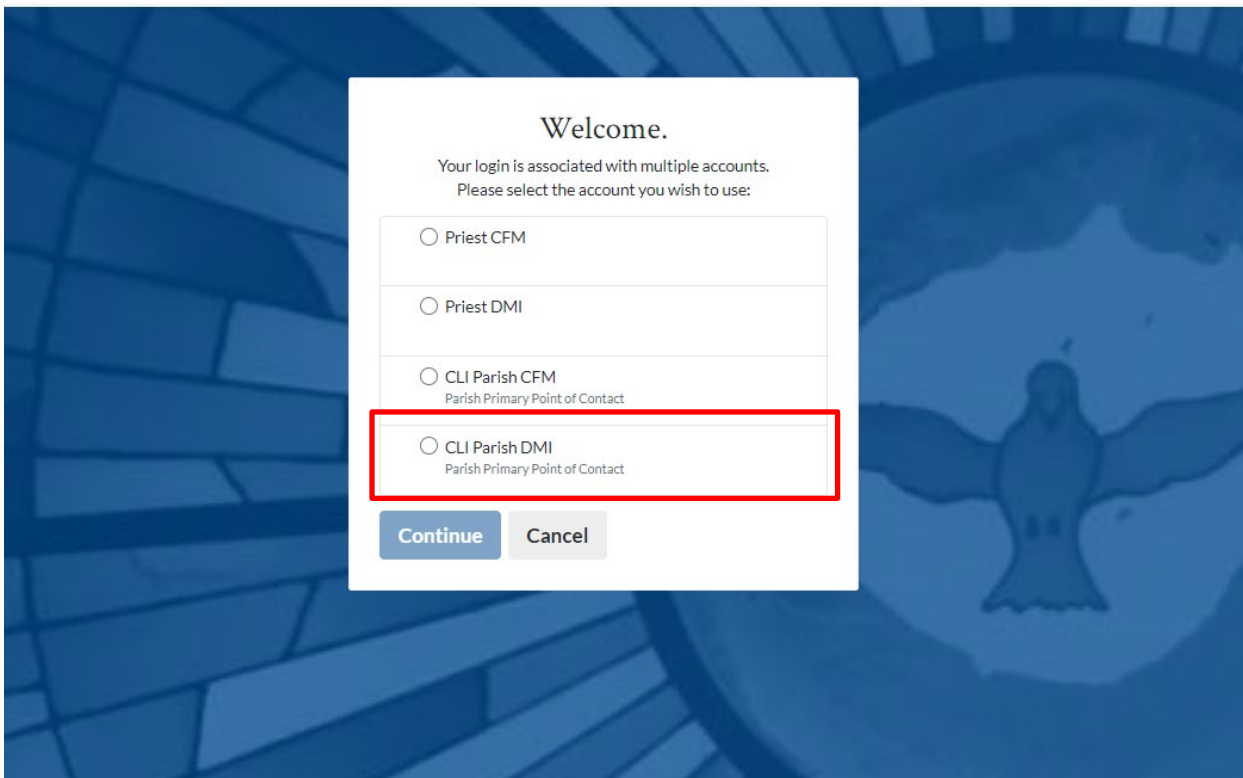

## DISCIPLE MAKER INDEX QUICK START GUIDE (Called for More Participants)

1. Once you have set up your username and password, log in to the Catholic Leadership Institute Portal at <https://portal.catholicleaders.org>
2. After logging in you will see a screen with a blue background with a white box, asking you to navigate to either your Called for More or Disciple Maker Index dashboards.
  - a. A priest user will see “Priest CFM” or “Priest DMI,” while Parish Primary Points of Contact options will be represented with your Parish Name followed by “CFM” or “DMI.”
  - b. **If you are assigned to multiple parishes you will see an option for each parish.**
3. To navigate to your Disciple Maker Index dashboard, where you can view your schedule, access the survey link to share with parishioners, and print paper copies, select the “DMI” Option.

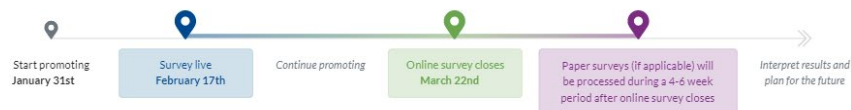


