THIS YEAR'S TOPIC

A Bishop's Role in an *Apostolic Age: Fostering Presbyteral Zeal and Shaping Diocesan Priorities* speaks directly to the heart of your "yes" to episcopal leadership in the Church.

We know that you balance multiple responsibilities that are vital part of your call to be a Shepherd of your flock and that some of the duties and tasks can become a gravitational pull that leaves little room for the deeper work of inspiring zeal, forming priests, and setting a clear vision for your diocese. This session is a chance to step back, refocus, and reclaim the fullness of your episcopal role in a rapidly changing societal climate.

We are no longer living in a Christendom age of the Church. As Msgr. James Shea, President of the University of Mary, observed: "The days of social support for the faith are over... Bishops must now lead with apostolic courage, raising up priests who are not merely administrators but joyful witnesses who know they were made for such a time as this."

In this session, you will be led through expert facilitation of this topic, discuss this and other pressing needs of your episcopacy, pray together, and enjoy time in restful fraternity. This is your moment, not only in the way you lead the Church, but in the ways you cultivate your growth and life with the Lord. Pope Leo XIV recently shared in his message to bishops that before you are a sheepherd, you are a sheep in God's own flock,

"If we are to lead the Churches entrusted to our care, we must let ourselves be profoundly renewed by Jesus, the Good Shepherd..."

Your role is critical to the Church's vitality in this new apostolic era. Come and see how this session can strengthen and renew your commitment as Shepherd of the Church.
