### **Overview of Report Options**

- 1. Follow the directions in the "Accessing Your DMI Results on the CLI Portal" guide to access the DMI Analytics & Reports.
- 2. At the top of the Analytics Screen is a brief overview of:
  - a. The percent of active parishioners who completed the survey (this number is based on userprovided data of average weekly Mass attendance.)
  - b. Total number of Online Surveys completed.
  - c. The number of Paper Surveys completed.
  - d. A pie-chart that visually displays the percentage of online responses vs. paper responses out of the total answered surveys.

#### Custom and Context

- Demographics
  - Lists the demographic data about parishioners who have taken the DMI
- Strengths & Opportunities
  - Questions for which your parish had the strongest positive and negative results based on strongly agree or high frequency
- Benchmarks
  - Select a question to benchmark with other similar parishes
- Cross Tabulation
  - Discover comparisons between frequency, agreement, and demographic questions
- Key Leader Perspective
  - Additional insights from parishioners who report being heavily involved in the life of the parish.

#### **Beliefs, Effectiveness, and Drivers for Big Outcomes**

- Key Drivers
  - Questions that are statistically significant with respect to a parishioner's likelihood to recommend the parish, say the parish is helping them grow spiritually, and frequency with which they are sharing their faith
- Belief in Core Catholic Teaching
  - Questions related to parishioners' degree of belief in core teachings of the faith
- Effectiveness of Parish Support
  - o Questions related to how well the parish supports parishioners personally and spiritually

#### Four Factors of a Thriving Parish

- Leadership Indicators
  - Questions most directly related to parish leadership
- Sunday Experience
  - o Questions directly related to the Sunday experience
- Spiritual Practices
  - o Questions related to the faith practices of your people
- Missionary Impulse
  - o Questions related to the missionary discipleship practices of your people



### Viewing & Navigating Reports

(

- 1. All reports are dynamic and interactive. After you navigate to a report screen by clicking "View Report," you will see a series of color-coded bars which visually represent responses with a legend explaining what the different colors represent. Questions fall into one of 3 categories:
  - a. "Agree/Disagree" Represented by blue/orange bars.
  - b. "Frequency" Represented by shades of green.
  - c. Catholic Journey questions are violet.
- 2. Once you are on a specific Report Page, you can navigate back to the initial Reports Dashboard by clicking "Go to Reports Dashboard" in the top left of your screen.

3. If you would like to print a copy of a given report, click on the blue **Export PDF** button. This will bring you to a Print screen. In the Destination Box, select your printer. Note that you can also save as a PDF.



- 4. To view more details on a specific question, hover your cursor/arrow over a color in a bar.
  - a. You will see a breakdown of the number of respondents corresponding to that color out of the total respondents to the question.
  - b. Note that the number of responses for a specific question may be lower than the total number of survey responses overall, as people may have skipped a question.
  - c. To see the numbers related to a different response, move your cursor over a different color.

6. In the sample below, questions are filtered to only display people who responded they were between the ages of 36-45. You can use this filtering to compare how different audiences responded to the same questions.



7. You can also choose to omit specific response categories in the bar charts by clicking on the legend. In the example below, the responses of "Neither Agree nor Disagree" have been removed from the display, indicated on the legend with that option being crossed out.

- 3. The "Benchmarking" option shows responses to individual questions in the context of other survey responses. These include:
  - a. The Top Three Parishes across all survey responses from all arch/dioceses.
  - b. All Parishes across all survey responses from all arch/dioceses.
  - c. Your previous DMI Survey responses, if applicable.
  - d. The average from all parishes who have taken the DMI in your arch/diocese.
  - e. Parishes with similar attendance from all arch/dioceses
  - f. Parishes who have the same demographic setting (Urban, Suburban, Rural) from all arch/dioceses
  - g. Parishes of similar size (Large, Medium, Small) based on size categories from CARA from all arch/dioceses.
