THIS YEAR'S TOPIC

This next generation was a high priority among your brother bishops when they were polled this year about the topic for this year's session. The cultural and spiritual landscape of the Catholic Church continues to evolve rapidly. The challenges that we face around an aging Church are not a new reality. The lack of presence and participation from Catholic youth within the Church is an acute concern among Catholics across the world. Multiple studies in the religious and secular sectors show a steep decline in religious practice among these generations and yet there are bright spots of opportunity if we are willing to reflect and seek to answer the question "How does the Church create a space for Millennials and Gen Zers?"

In your tremendous responsibilities as a bishop to teach, govern, and sanctify, you are tasked with navigating changing times to ensure the Church is present and vital for future generations. This task requires knowledge and understanding of the next generation – their strengths, influences, behaviors, challenges, and worldview. As the demographics of the Church's leadership shifts, it becomes imperative to adapt our mindset and innovate our practices so that we can better attract and accompany younger generations into the life of the entire Church. This session serves as an opportunity to pray, reflect, and discern with your brother bishops on this important topic for our time. At this session we hope to dive into pertinent questions such as:

- How do we help parishes, schools, and other Catholic institutions think and respond differently about these generations?
- How can priests be formed in ministering to these generations?
- How do we create spaces and opportunities within your diocesan central administration for the next generation of leaders?
