Key Finding	Explanation	Interpretation
<i>Growth via Mass</i>	The parish helps me grow spiritually by offering vibrant and engaging Sunday Masses.	It is clear from the survey and the positive overall response that people are hungry for and desirous of God, Church and our Parish.
<i>Recommend Parish</i>	I would recommend my parish to a friend.	
<i>Parish helps spiritual growth</i>	My parish helps me grow spiritually as a Catholic.	People are keenly aware of something more, something bigger than themselves.
<i>Growth via Preaching</i>	The parish helps me grow spiritually by preaching and homilies that connect my faith with my everyday life.	Sunday Mass and our programs such as Bible Study, Reach More, etc. are well received and a clear strength for St. Patrick's.

Key Finding	Explanation	Interpretation
<i>Belief- Scripture is word of God</i>	I personally believe scripture is the word of God.	There is evidence from the responses that there is some lack of understanding/belief that the scripture is the Word of God. We can do a better job communicating this during Mass, providing more perspective in this important area.
<i>Community Welcoming</i>	The parish helps me connect with a local Catholic community by making me feel welcomed and accepted.	
<i>Growth via Forming as a Disciple</i>	The parish helps me grow spiritually by forming me as a disciple of Jesus Christ.	<p>There is also evidence that our parish could be more welcoming especially to new parishioners. This is something for all of us to keep in mind and may also reflect the strong relationships and bonds that many people in our parish already share. We also think this may be due to lack of opportunities for connection with others, including our lack of facilities to promote deeper connections between parishioners.</p> <p>Overall the parish also feels we need to provide more support to help them grow as a disciple of Jesus Christ, as well as support how to share their personal witness story in conversation with others.</p>
<i>Conversations- Sharing my personal Story</i>	My parish equips me to have conversations about my faith with family and friends by teaching me how to share my personal witness story.
